## Process for Review of Musical Selections for Public Performance

- 1. Music department members will submit all music selections for public performance to music department chairs.
- 2. Music department chairs will review music using the following criteria:
  - Is the music selected on the basis of its musical and educational value rather than its religious context?
  - Does the teaching of music with sacred text focus on musical and artistic considerations?
  - Are the traditions of different people shared and respected?
  - Is the role of sacred music one of neutrality, neither promoting nor inhibiting religious views?
  - Are all local and school policies regarding religious holidays and the use of sacred music observed?
  - Is the use of sacred music and religious symbols or scenery avoided? Is performance in devotional settings avoided?
  - Is there sensitivity to the various religious beliefs represented by the students and parents?
- 3. If any objectionable lyrics/messages are found, the first step will be to make appropriate deletions or alterations to lyrics if possible.
- 4. If the music department chairs still have concerns about the possible interpretation of a piece of music, the music will then be submitted to the building principal for review.
- 5. Music determined as inappropriate by either department chairs or administration will not be performed and, if possible, returned to the vendor.
- 6. Musical selections and performance program will be submitted to the principal at least two weeks in advance of any performance.

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
